

Graduation Project

Catalog Data:

Computer-based project design and development. Project documentation. Presentation of project's progress. Realization of literature survey and the typical phases of the system development life cycle.

In this course, you need to work with a supervisor from your program. Under your supervisor's directions you need to complete a project. Your project could be a software project or a research project. In your project please try to follow a scientific research approach. In other words, in the graduation project, each student shall design and complete an independent study project in one or more areas of concentrated study. The purpose of the graduation project is to assure that the student is able to apply, analyze, synthesize and evaluate information and communicate significant knowledge and understanding. It is the responsibility of each student to fulfill the requirements. The Supervisor(s) will provide guidance and direction in the fulfillment of these responsibilities. Projects should be undertaken by individual students. The end product will be based on oral presentations to a jury committee and a comprehensive written report.

You need to follow Atılım University Thesis format for your reports:

Your project report should include **at least** the following titles.

Project Report Titles

Title of the project

Abstract of the project:

Your abstract should be at most 300 words. In your abstract define the problem that is attempted in this study, your contribution to the field by this study and outline of your results

Table of contents

Should be automatically generated by Word program

Introduction

General description of the problem, motivation, related work, and goals, related definitions, related literature and background

Results

Description of your work, experimental results,

Conclusion

Conclusions, comparison of your results with the ones found in the literature, and your conclusions and directions for further research

References

You should use the style that is valid for thesis in Atılım University

Appendices

Your code may be included here, especially the parts that is related with your contribution and the open source developed content
